<u>H</u>ow often do we give praise and glory to world leaders, and actors based on their popularity and forget to give the honor and glory to the One Being without whom we would not exist in the first place.

Each day we live, each breath we take is given unto us as a gift by God and as such, it is just another chance for us to turn away from the temptations of this life to the fulfillment of eternal life with Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son.

If you tithe with the expectation of receiving praise or denominational recognition for your tithing, or a monetary reward then you have received your reward, but tithing with an open heart is counted as precious in God's eyes.

So when you tithe, give generously out of love for God and out of Christ like love for you neighbor, withholding nothing from your tithing, requiring only that to God be the glory in all things, for tithing is not only about the cash, but about time in love.

Works done for self glorification are of themselves selfish and temporary in nature, their reward, are like everything of this finite life, last only as long as this life can sustain them, quite often they fail to last no longer then the day.

Our Lord is worthy of all praise and tithing is a form of praise, for nothing can exist without His sufferance, our tithings help support the needs of the body of Christ on earth, but our tithing must first be given out of love, not dogmatic requirements.

Remember man that thou aret dust and to dust Thou shalt return, but the gift of eternal life is provided thee when thou turneth away from the iniquities of this life to the reconciliation with thy Heavenly Father and eternal life in Jesus His Son.

<u>Thou</u> art worthy of all, prayer, praise and honor oh Lord God of creation, for the mind of man, cannot conceive of the magnitude of Thy existence.

Holy is the Name of Thy Son Jesus, who provided the grace of reconciliation, with his birth, life, teachings, death and resurrection that we would have the gift that enables us to return to Thee. Yea and amen, the truth is that Thou, oh Heavenly Father, Thy Holy Spirit and Thy Son Jesus are worthy of praise and supplication, as no other can be, for Thou art the source of life itself.
